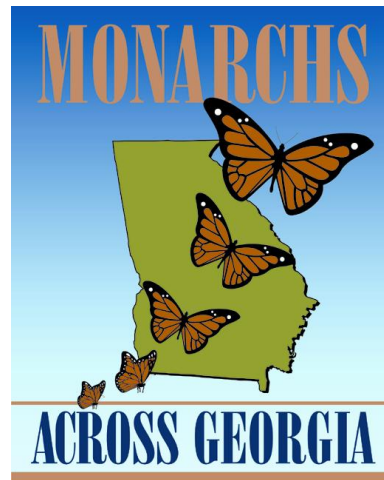


What: *Monarchs Across Georgia* is offering a 10-hour, 1-PLU credit teacher workshop about the biology and ecology of the Monarch butterfly!
